E. PUBLIC FORUM

Pierre St-Germain, Director of Dining and Conference Services

- Reminds Senate that students have two weeks after the start of the semester to change their meal plan.
- New hot meal machines were installed around campus.
- 2 weeks to change meal plan after start of the semester
- Student composting beat testing in the dining hall
- Renovation of Rams Den and Hope dining hall this summer
- Both will be in full renovation coming next fall
- In about a month we will have our yearly survey for the student body which is very important that we get feedback from the student body to improve dining services

- There will be some prizes for the surveys, looking into doing something similar this year as well
- In a month we start ramadan, that way students who are observing will be able to have something in their dorms for the first meal, and eat in the dining hall at the end of the day Chair Buono: Hi, thank you so much for coming, is the system for ramadan is there some sort of online system
 - If the student wants something that is halal they are able to access that through asking in the dining hall, no longer 100% necessary to email ahead of time

Senator Hudson:

What renovations are you doing specifically for the Rams Den

- Changing the carpet to vinyl tiles, we are refixturing, removing certain aspects, for example the neon clock, not going to be changing stations or anything like that, more of a active change to modernize the space

Senator Gonzalez:

Are you guys planning on changing the furniture as well?

- I would like to change that, and it will be determined as of next month. It is about a 4 month lead time to bring in that much furniture, for certain the furniture inside the mainfair will all be changed. We need something in the rams den that is able to fold up, and compress like we have now. What I don't like about the rams den is the tables. Most of the wheels are broken so they slide right now. We are trying to put up a screen for movies and things like that. That way we can show movies and various things in the rams den

Senator Buono:

Is there a place that we can advise students to go for the ramadan request

- In a week or two on the dining services website there will be something on the facebook and website

Senator Fleming:

How has the composting been going at the dining halls

- It would be better if we had a little more enthusiasm, we need to figure out a way to engage the student body better, it's something that we're hoping to do at every orientation. Having it fully active at orientation would make it less of an afterthought. We do have sustainability ambassadors, but they do have to stay there for a certain amount of time. We are trying to figure out a way to further engage the students.

Chair Cayer:

I'm a dishwasher for a dining service. One way that we could advertise composted food would be to advertise what happens when the food is not composted.

- There tend to be fewer student dishwashers at butterfield which would be the best to have more staff at butterfield so the composting can happen
- Working on an allergen free place in mainfaire!

SS-24/25-28 – AMENDMENT CALLING FOR CHANGE IN A COLLEGE REPRESENTATIVE REQUIREMENT

<u>Whereas</u>, University of Rhode Island Student Senate bylaws **Article I. Section 1.2** currently stipulate:

"College Representatives shall serve ex officio as the formal liaison to the college which they are elected to represent, and to this end shall work directly with the Dean of the corresponding college and with the Dean's subordinates. They shall meet with the Dean of their college at least once a month and report to Chairperson of the Academic Affairs Committee in regards to these meetings."

In so many words, that college representatives meet with a dean or deans subordinates monthly

Whereas, A number of the months in the academic year are too short or busy to fulfill this requirement

<u>Whereas</u>, A lower bar for entry would be more accomplishable, and incentivize representatives to actually meet with their respective deans

<u>Resolved</u>, the University of Rhode Island Student Senate bylaws **Article I. Section 1.2** be rewritten to read:

"College Representatives shall serve ex officio as the formal liaison to the college which they are elected to represent, and to this end shall work directly with the Dean of the corresponding college and with the Dean's subordinates. They shall meet with the Dean of their college at least twice a semester and report to Chairperson of the Academic Affairs Committee in regards to these meetings."
