DOT Cronan:

- No decreases unless they requested so
- Not going through every single club
- Took into account what they are doing for the URI community
- A big part of the budget this year is the amounts that they were allocated this year and the year before
- VDOT John, helped look at how much money we are giving them and how much they have requested in the past

VP Feroz:

- Every club that requested a certain amount of money, I'm trying to see why certain clubs got these amount

President Goswami:

- Has anyone objected to the budget?

DOT:

 Everyone was welcome to be here tonight, people are generally happy! Quite a lot of time and effort has gone into this

Page 2:

- Bridge USA and other clubs that have waived their budget are still being re-recognized but not getting budgets

Page 3:

- Gave a ton of time for year 4 clubs to get re-recognize and submit their budget

Senator Sundell:

- Does the budget roll over?

DOT Cronan:

- No unfortunately not

Senator Martin:

What happens if budget is unused?

DOT Cronan:

- Gets reallocated

Page 4:

- College Dems and Republicans waived their budgets

Page 5:

- Printing costs should be going down with the new subscription services in the next few years

Page 6:

- Year 3 orgs got allocated more money
- Year 1 and year 2 don't fill out the budget request forms

Page 7:

- President Goswami:
 - Where would funding from clubs that are re-recognized after the budget get their funding from
 - Contingency

Page 8:

- Renaissance yearbook: historically got funding in the past, isn't technically a student organization at this point. Still doing senior photos!

Page 9:

- Any club that is not outlined as getting funding right now but has till april 1st to get the funding would get money from the contingency fund
- Idea next year: clubs that are recognized in the spring will be year 1 in the following year
- Difficult when people are recognized this late in this year, want to do recognitions at the start of the semester so that it's not a running thing, raw and in the works

Chair Milner:

- How and when do we move stipends around?

DOT Cronan:

- If there was an overall sentiment that the stipends weren't good anymore than we could change it but unfortunately because the bylaws say not to change the stipends
