E. PUBLIC FORUM

- Catherine Ahern from the CFR program (content may be heavy, section will end around 7:20)
 - Narcan Kits are available after the meeting if you so please
 - Based out of College of pharmacy
 - Statewide program, funded by department of public health
 - Comes from Opioid settlement fund and rhode island is given 50,000 narcan kits every year
 - Program Purpose: Born out of the idea that anyone can be a first responder when it comes to an overdose emergency. Most bystanders are the ones that respond to the crisis when it happens. It is usually not the first responders that come on scene
 - Partner with over 60 organization throughout rhode island to dispense the narcan
 - Narcan can be mailed to people throughout the state of Rhode Island as well As fentanyl testing stripes
 - Provide training for overdose response
 - We take volunteers throughout the school to work with us
 - There is always work to be done!
 - Recently we were able to work with some students to tailor to college students
 - Fentanyl testing strip demonstration
 - Harm Reduction: Substance use is not inherently evil, but is a risky behavior.

 Trying to minimize negative health and social impacts associated with drug use.
 - Drug testing facilities: allowed to go to get drugs tested to make sure they are safe to use

Speaker Rinne: Is it no secret that people on campus use THC cartridges? Is there any risk for fentanyl in these?

- No, because the boiling point for Fentanyl in the cartridges would not get hot enough in these cartridges, therefore there is no possibility of a risk from these.
- You can only provide help to people that want help

Lucas: You mentioned students not feeling comfortable to come forward, if there is an overdose however what is the procedure for calling in an overdose

- Rhode Island has the good samaritan law that a person can not get in trouble for calling in an overdose. Whether it is on campus or off campus. There is no intent to punish people and instead provide them with help
- People here can be affected differently by overdose
- Overdose risk factors: Loss of tolerance after a period of abstinence, using unregulated substances or RX opioids alone, mixing substances, compromised health conditions,
- Checking in behavior make sure your leaving with who you came with, someone might not just be asleep (don't be afraid to be a creep make sure their chest is rising and falling),
- Responding to an Opioid overdose:
 - How to tell if someone is overdosing: 1. Can't be woken up, 2. Slow or no breathing 3. pale /ashen skin
 - Sternum rub: enough of a pain stimuli that if someone would wake up if they could
 - Call 911 every single time
 - 2 minutes for narcan to go from the nose to the brain
 - CPR till they are consequence
 - Narcan restores breathing but not consequences, this is okay because they are able to stay alive
 - If someone is not responsive after administering narcan: Recovery position is recommended, cross the knee over the body and make sure they are on the side
 - If someone is not responsive after 2 minutes give them a second dose
 - Best practice for second dose of narcan is to put it in the opposite nostril
 - Post overdose support: make sure someone stay with them for the next two hours to make sure that the overdose is over and the body has had time to process the opioids
 - It is okay to administer expired narcan but it will lose its potency
 - Vending machine on campus for narcan

Speaker Rinne: is there anything that we can do as student leaders to get the word out about

these programs

- Take care of people, don't shame others, that will make it harder for addicted people to connect. Being so involved on campus is already a great way. If we hear of cool fun things that we can table at please let us know

Chair Wentworth: Is there a certain time of year that we should look out for, for when overdoses are more common

- Peak summer and Peak winter
