SS-24/25-02 • BILL CALLING FOR THE ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF "BridgeUSA" AS A SENATE-RECOGNIZED ORGANIZATION

SS-24/25-03 – BILL CALLING FOR THE ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR MAINTENANCE PROJECTS AT THE NORTHWOODS CHALLENGE COURSE

<u>Whereas</u>, the Northwoods Challenge Course, located on URI property, provides free team building services and leadership trainings for dozens of student organizations, and

<u>Whereas</u>, deferred maintenance projects coupled with a series of strong storms has caused severe structural deficiencies at the Northwoods Challenge Course, and

<u>Whereas</u>, in order to safely reopen in the fall, the Northwoods Challenge Course is in urgent needs of a \$12,000 grant to fund much needed repairs, and

<u>Therefore</u>, these repairs are essential to continuing to offer free services to student organizations now therefore be it,

Resolved, that \$12,000 be immediately allocated to the Northwoods Challenge Course from the Student Senate's Tax Apportion accounts.
