# SS-23/24-34 – BILL CALLING FOR THE REVISION OF THE STUDENT SENATE MODEL ORGANIZATION CONSTITUTION

<u>Whereas</u>, the Student Senate Model Organization Constitution will serve as the baseline for what is expected of all Student Senate Recognized organizations, and

<u>Whereas</u>, the rules and functions of a Student Senate recognized organization are clearly listed and organized, now therefore be it,

**Resolved**, that organizations will have the ability to pass their own constitutions using this model to specify the functions and needs of that organization. As listed in the model constitution, any amendments need to be voted on and approved by a two-thirds majority of full members, then must be approved by the student organization committee, and be it further,

**Resolved**, that the Student Organizations Committee's November 29th 2023 Student Organization Model Constitution will become an official senate document to be amended via bills with a majority vote, and be it further,

**Resolved**, that all student senate organizations will be required to amend and vote on their own constitutions and have them available on their URInvolved page to continue being a Student Senate recognized organization.
