We are very excited to offer a new and exciting hybrid/blended version of the organizational behavior class taught by a seasoned change management professional who has worked in a variety of advisory roles for Fortune 1000 clients, nonprofit organizations, and local government agencies throughout the United States.

The “hybrid/blended” designation is an important one as it combines the best elements of online and face-to-face learning in a small class format.
