Introduction to Music

Course Delivery

This course is completely online and delivered asynchronously. That means you do the work at your own convenience – no Zoom meetings! The course materials are delivered as an online text, you, the student, read and study the written materials, listen to the embedded music (as many times as you like), take assessments, and complete written assignments which are submitted in most cases through the course site.

Overview & Goals

Music is art as well as science. To be able to comprehend it to the fullest, we must, therefore, be able to appreciate both its emotional and intellectual content.

The aim of this course is very simple: to provide you with the tools for a basic understanding of music. It will not make you a musician or teach you how to write music. It will, however, give you the necessary background to understand what is going on technically when you listen to music so that your experience is not limited to a wash of sound that produces a certain feeling.

- Outcomes: **A4** – Understand the context and significance of **arts and design**, **B1**– **Write effective** and precise texts that fulfill their communicative purposes and address various audiences

Course Procedures

This course runs asynchronously; that is, you complete your work online at your own convenience. All the components of the class are open to you for the entire length of the class; you could conceivably finish the class early if you choose. The class consists of 35 online assessments, 5 written assignments, a midterm and a final exam.
