In Memory Of MICHAEL G. LAPOINTE

Michael G. Lapointe, 74, of Kingston, RI, died peacefully on his birthday, February 21, 2025 at Hope Health Hulitar Hospice Center.

Michael was a proud 1993 graduate of the University of Rhode Island Department of Theatre specializing in stage and theater management. He continued his career with URI Theatre as an Instructor of THE 100 Introduction to Theater, a Season House Manager, a Poster/Program Designer, and a theatre summer orientation recruiting advisor. He also served full-time as a beloved Resident Hall Director and he always put students first no matter what position he was holding. The students whose lives he touched and his URI colleagues were all an important part of Michael's 50 years at URI.

Michael was also an amateur photographer with a professional outcome. Outside, he was rarely seen without a camera hanging from around his neck. He saw beauty in most every shape and texture of nature all around him and was proud of his million pictures posted on Flikkar, a photography website. Michael's photographs can be seen on walls of buildings throughout the campus.

A Celebration of Life will be held at URI Theatre on June 1 for all of Michael's many students, colleagues, and friends. This was one of his last requests because he said he had so many vibrant memories of his days and nights in the Fine Arts Center. We are proud to honor that request.
