Director's Notes

Embarking on this timeless yet timely musical came after a semester-long season selection process department-wide that included students and faculty. The sad loss of Stephen Sondheim has sparked an unprecedented resurgence of his works and we were eager to honor his legacy as well. Paula McGlasson directed this musical at URI to rave reviews in 2004 (Is this the correct year?), starring our own multi-talented David Howard in the role of the Baker. Big shoes to fill!

I remember a conversation Renee (Fitzgerald) and I had last fall after a dress rehearsal of *Silent Sky* (Fall 21 season) in that we had exchanged similar experiences of needing to take a break from the ever-present bad news while making our commutes to campus. I expressed how it just seemed too much to carry when I needed to focus on lifting up our students after a tough two years of Covid distance learning and isolation, and Renee offered similar reactions to the anxiety-inducing headlines. But then, how to forge ahead with being an engaged citizen if we always choose to take ourselves out of the noise? Coupled with my own frustration on the current uptick in banning of stories across our nation, the concept was born.

I believe in the power of story – to discover, consider, learn, digest, wrestle with, and ultimately celebrate – to connect humans across cultures, across race, and across geography. Theatre is the ultimate experience of story-telling, even more so than the screens we all enjoy, as it is a unique experience that only exists for the audience for that performance. For that moment.

First produced 37 years ago, *Into the Woods* draws on *Grimm's Fairy Tales* as an origin of the story, a collection of published stories based on centuries of oral story-telling traditions in European cultures. James Lapine and Stephen Sondheim purposefully took these well-known tales and their tropes and turned them on their head in the creation of this ground-breaking musical. Embedded in these ancient stories lie socioeconomic-bias, gender-bias, and ableism. The cast embarked on a thoughtful and heartfelt conversation during rehearsal that informed choices made in this production. Questions were posed on the ideas that may be reinforced in our production, and we continued to hold those questions as we moved forward in our rehearsal process, with the end-goal of honoring the legacy of Lapine and Sondheim's work alongside engaging in current conversation across our society.
