OR, takes place (mostly) during one night in the life of Aphra Behn: poet, spy, and the first professional female playwright. Sprung from debtors' prison and desperate to get out of the spy trade, she has a shot at a production at one of only two London companies. But only if she can finish her play by morning despite interruptions from sudden new love, complicated royal love, and very dodgy ex-love who may murder the king in the morning. This neo-Restoration comedy is "...playful and highly literate," with "...imagination, radical instincts, and sardonic but generous humor."
