Winterizing Your Vehicle

PACK A SHOVEL & SNOWBRUSH/SCRAPER!

You may need to dig your car out and brush snow off your vehicle! We suggest letting your car warm up during this process so you're ready to go when you're done! Make sure your exhaust pipe is free of snow before turning on your vehicle- this prevents carbon monoxide poisoning!



MAINTAINENCE

Help your engine out! Fill your anti-freeze up before it gets cold

Keep your gas above half- the gas door can potentially freeze when temps drop! Check your brakes & fill your tires for better

Check your brakes & fill your tires for better traction on icy roads!



EMERGENCY KIT

Pack a flashlight, hats/gloves/blankets, nonperishable snacks, a first-aid kit, water, a charged battery pack, and some jumper cables in your car. You never know when they will come in handy!
