

# WINTER PARKING GUIDELINES

## EFFECTIVE DECEMBER THROUGH MARCH

The Winter Parking Guidelines are in effect from December to March. Declaration of a snow emergency resulting in a Full or Partial Parking Ban will be made by the Department of Public Safety. URI Communications and Marketing will make notifications through email. To ensure efficient snow removal operations and the safety of the campus community, Public Safety and Facilities Operations ask for your cooperation during a Parking Ban.

### **FULL PARKING BAN:**

#### **NO PARKING** at these locations:

- All roadways and roadside parking throughout the campus (This includes the on-street parking next to the Carlotti Bldg and the Multicultural Center)
- Commuter Lots (6pm – 7am)
- Faculty/Staff Lots (6pm – 7am)

#### **APPROVED** parking locations:

- Lot 26- Keaney, Lot 22-Brookside, and Lot 31- Plains Rd Solar Panel lot for Resident permit holders, Fine Arts South (evening classes only)

### **PARTIAL PARKING BAN:**

#### **NO PARKING:**

- All roadways and roadside parking throughout the campus (This includes the on-street parking next to the Carlotti Bldg. and the Multicultural Center)

#### **APPROVED** parking locations:

- Students, staff, and visitors with approved parking privileges may park in designated parking lots during a Partial Parking Ban

Please be aware of these areas and park appropriately when inclement weather is expected. Vehicles parked in these areas during a Parking Ban will be ticketed and/or towed at the owner's expense. Please view the campus map [here](#).

Continued snow clearing will require that vehicles be moved to other lots when the owners are notified.

This includes Athletic Teams, Students, Faculty, Staff and Visitors who are traveling and plan to leave their vehicle on campus during the Winter Parking Ban period.
