

Residency Application for Undergraduate and Non-Degree Students

Undergraduate and non-degree students applying for instate residency re-classification must submit the attached University of Rhode Island Tuition Residency Application. The application must be completed fully, and all required documentation should be attached. If there are any items that cannot be provided, a letter of explanation should be included with your application.

It is strongly encouraged that the Residency Policy be thoroughly reviewed prior to application submission. The policy established by the Rhode Island Office of the Post-Secondary Commissioner under which applications for instate residency will be approved, or denied, is rigorous. Please be sure all criteria for eligibility are met.

It is important to note that applications for residency re-classification are due prior to the start of the semester for which re-classification is being sought. Decisions are not retroactive and will be effective for the semester which next follows the date of application.

If you are claiming re-classification as a **DEPENDENT STUDENT**, please provide the following documents:

- A copy of page 1 of your parents' Federal Income Tax Return for the most recent year.
- A certified copy of your parents' RI State Tax Return for the most recent year. (A copy may be obtained from the RI Division of Taxation, One Capitol Hill, Providence, RI 02908.)
- A copy of both parents' Rhode Island driver's licenses and vehicle registrations.
- A copy of all Trusts, Wills, Support, or Custody Decrees or Agreements affecting you, if applicable.
- A copy of your parents' current rental lease or evidence of property ownership. The names of the lessees or owners, the property address, and the effective dates must be clearly indicated.
- A notarized statement from the Town Clerk indicating the original date(s) of voter registration for both parents.

If you are claiming re-classification as an INDEPENDENT STUDENT, please provide the following documents:

- A copy of your Federal and State Income Tax Returns for the past 2 years.
- A copy of your parents' Federal Income Tax Return for the past 2 years, OR, a notarized statement from your parents' that you were not claimed as a dependent on their Federal Income Tax Return for the past 2 years and that they have no intention of such claim in the future.
- A copy of your Rhode Island driver's license and vehicle registration.
- A copy of your current rental lease or evidence of property ownership. The names of the lessees or owners, the property address, and the effective dates must be clearly indicated. If a formal lease is not available, a notarized statement from the landlord detailing dates of residence may be substituted.
- A copy of all loan agreements which clearly shows the names and signatures of all parties to these agreements, if applicable.
- A notarized statement from the Town Clerk indicating the original date(s) of your voter registration.
