Monitoring is scheduled for every other week, but you may monitor weekly. Monitor between 6 AM and 9 AM, except on the water collection days. Approximate times listed are for when Narrow River monitors collect water samples (aimed toward low tide). Other rivers/streams should collect samples by 9 AM. Samples may be collected and delivered on any of the four days, usually Wednesday through Saturday (10 AM - 3 PM). It is better to collect the water samples earlier rather than later. After collection immediately bring the samples on ice in a cooler to the Coastal Institute in Kingston, URI. Please notify us at least 1 day in advance if you must reschedule delivery of water samples to a different date. An earlier date is <a href="much preferable">much preferable</a> to one after the designated collection period. Let us know if you want to drop off your samples on the cart outside instead of coming into the lab.
