Overview	Capstone course for HDF majors. Students are required to complete an internship; students will take a seminar course concurrently.	Students are required to secure* and complete an internship; students will take an online seminar concurrently with the internship <i>*assistance provided by Career Education Specialist</i>
Hours & Credits	Separate field experience & seminar credit HDF 480 (<i>field experience</i>) = 6-12 credits HDF 481 (<i>seminar</i>) = 1 credit	Separate field experience & seminar credit* ITR 302 (<i>field experience</i>) = variable credit & hours. See over for information. ITR 304 (<i>seminar</i>) = 3 credits <i>*ITR 302 & 304 are taken concurrently</i>
Pre-requisite	Permission of instructor Minimum of 90 credits earned	Minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA Minimum of 60 earned credits
Registration Procedure	Students register with permission numbers. Registration form is due April 25 or Dec 5 the semester preceding the internship.	Students register with permission number by individual appointment with their ITR adviser. Procurement of an internship prior to the start of the semester is required. Where to begin: Attend an ITR Info Session weekdays @ 11am & 2pm in the Career Center (Roosevelt Hall).
Internship Deadline	Registration form is due April 25 or Dec 5 the semester preceding the internship.	One week BEFORE the internship semester. Recommended that students secure their internship the semester before the internship semester.
Internship Seminar	Meets in person on campus.	Meets online through Sakai
HDF Experiential Requirement	Fulfills HDF experiential requirement.	Fulfills HDF experiential requirement* <i>*students using ITR for the requirement must be sure to complete a minimum of 6 credits of ITR 302.</i>
Total Credits		Students may earn up to 24 credits of ITR
