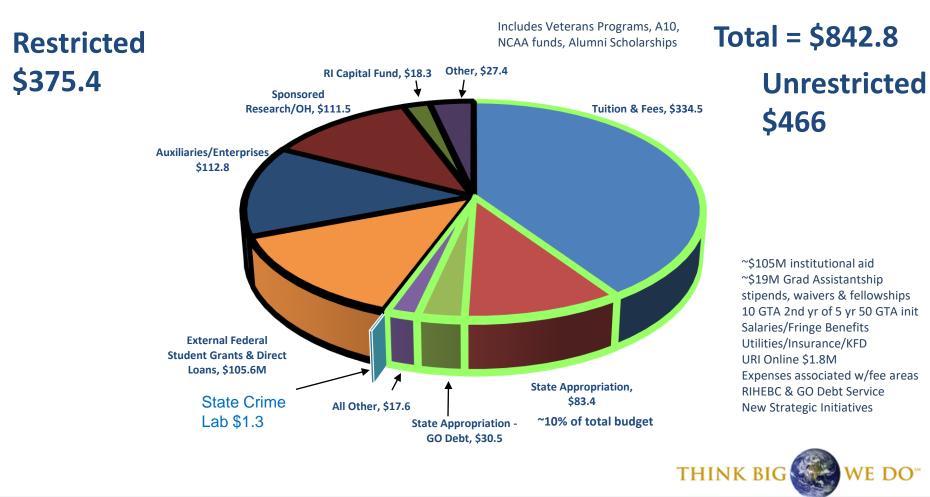

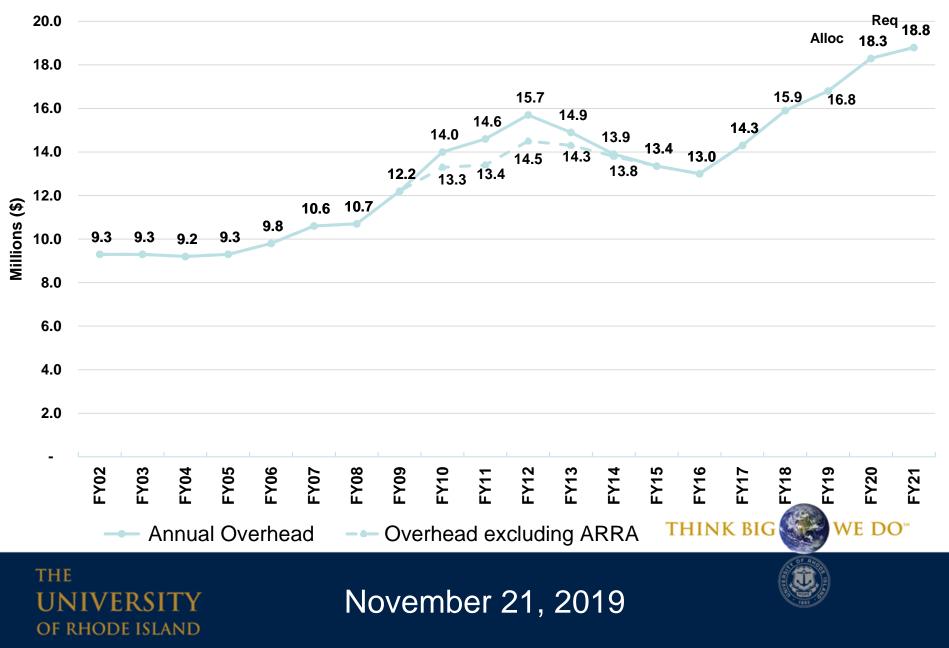

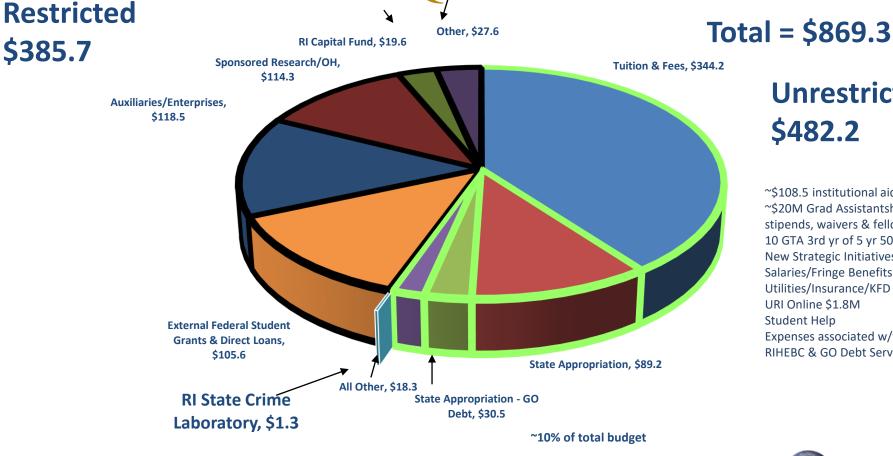


OVERHEAD REVENUE
