

- What is Pneumococcal Disease?
  Pneumococcal (noo-muh-kok-ul) disease is caused by Streptococcus pneumoniae, a bacteria commonly found in your nose and throat.
- How do you Catch it?
  You can catch Pneumococcal bacteria
  from infected people who cough or sneeze
  around you.
- Why should I be concerned?

  Pneumococcal disease kills more people in the United States each year than all other vaccine-preventable diseases combined!

Pneumonia is the most **COMMON** form caused by *Streptococcus pneumoniae*.

Pneumococci are a major cause of the **900,000** cases of community-acquired pneumonia (CAP) in the US each year. Approximately **175,000** annually are hospitalized in the US with pneumococcal pneumonia.


