

ITALIAN IEP – Entering Fall 2022

The BA program in Italian requires a minimum of 30 credits (excluding ITL 100, 101, and 102). You must take at least one ITL class in each semester. As an IEP student, you should take two classes in your junior year, including ITL 305* or ITL 4xx, prior to going abroad. Please contact your IEP Director to explore other options, such as taking only up to ITL 206 and/or ITL 301/ITL 302*, before your year abroad. Up to 3 credits from ITL 390 or ITL 395 (both courses are taught in English) can be used towards the major. You must take two 400-level courses in order to complete your Italian major. If you start at the ITL104/205 level or above and have taken 3-4 years of Italian or more at HS, you might be able to receive 3 credits of ITL toward your Italian major (<https://bit.ly/urilinginccred>).

Courses throughout this guide marked with an asterisk (*) are not required, however are strongly recommended.

Please note: You will need to pay a “credit overload” fee for each credit enrolled above 19 in any given semester (and need permission from your Dean’s Office to do so). Summer and winter coursework similarly incur additional costs beyond your fall and spring semester tuition.

General Education Outcomes can be completed when possible, including while abroad (one ITL course will cover outcomes A3 and C2).

Please note: At the end of your junior year, your proficiency level should be Intermediate-High on the ACTFL scale. To reach this target, it may be recommended to supplement your language classwork with tutoring, summer courses, etc. Discuss options with your IEP Director.

Take ITL 301, 302, 305* during the URI Summer Program in Italy* to complete your major quickly/help you get ready for the year abroad.

Please note: ITL 305* is a very important course to help you prepare for your coursework abroad. You need a permission number from your instructor to take it together with ITL 206. If possible, taking a 400-level ITL course before your year abroad will also be helpful.

We require that during your year abroad, you take an Italian Language course and an Engineering course of your choice. For the rest, you can take any course that you need in order to complete your majors, including any General Education outcome(s). Credits completed abroad will vary by eligibility, what is offered, and your successful completion. Aside from the Intensive Language Course, you have to pass at least 2 courses in Italian at one of our partner universities to be eligible for a 6-month internship, and to keep/extend your student visa status.</p>

Preapproved Engineering Curriculum Adjustments:

Do not deter from the prescribed engineering curriculum sheet you are following unless confirmed with your engineering advisor. The following preapproved adjustments correspond to the engineering-specific curriculum sheet you are following:

Chemical Engineering: **ECN 201** should most easily fit in the Sophomore Year Fall Semester (although can be taken in any fall or spring semester, and is normally offered in the summer).

Civil Engineering: **STA 409** should be attempted in the Junior Year Spring Semester (seek to complete **1 Professional Elective** during your year abroad or during a summer or winter term at URI). **CVE 355** can be taken in the Senior Year Fall Semester (your 5th year, after you return from your year abroad).

Computer Engineering: **MTH 215** can be attempted in Sophomore or Junior Year Spring (and is normally offered in the fall and summer).

Industrial and Systems Engineering: Enroll in **MCE 201** in the Sophomore Year Fall Semester and **ISE 240/241** in the Sophomore Year Spring Semester.
