Methodology in Brief: This poll was funded by the Rhode Island Foundation and designed and analyzed by the Social Science Institute for Research, Education, and Policy (SSIREP). It is part of a larger project on the state and local media landscape in Rhode Island that uses various methods to study how Rhode Islanders consume and interact with state and local media. The survey is one component of the larger project, and is intended to measure Rhode Islander's attitudes toward the state and local media as well as (presented here), where they are getting their state and local coronavirus information. Only survey data relating to the current coronavirus pandemic is presented here. Data from the rest of the survey will be released at a later date, after further evaluation.

The survey was administered by YouGov. YouGov interviewed 607 respondents who were then matched down to a sample of 600 to produce the final dataset. The survey was offered in English. The respondents were matched to a sampling frame on gender, age, race, and education. The frame was constructed by stratified sampling from the full 2017 American Community Survey (ACS) 1-year sample with selection within strata by weighted sampling with replacements (using the person weights on the public use file). The matched cases were weighted to the sampling frame using propensity scores. The matched cases and the frame were combined and a logistic regression was estimated for inclusion in the frame. The propensity score function included age, gender, race/ethnicity, and years of education. The propensity scores were grouped into deciles of the estimated propensity score in the frame and post-stratified according to these deciles. The weights were then post-stratified on 2016 Presidential vote choice, and a four-way stratification of gender, age (4-categories), race (4-categories), and education (4-categories), to produce the final weight. The survey is also representative of Rhode Island's diverse geography.

For each question regarding Covid-19, cross-tabulations have been provided for responses across gender, college education, Hispanic ethnicity, race (white/non-white), political party identification (coded to include Independents who indicated they lean toward one party as party leaners), political ideology, income, and pandemic-related work interruption (coded as experiencing a work interruption if they indicated they have lost their job, been furloughed or had their hours or wages reduced as a result of the pandemic).
