Discussion focused on the Faculty Senate research committees and whether they have information on how indirect funds are spent.

What about CELS? Is it reasonable to ask the college what they spend indirect costs/funds on? Cheryl suggested that she will bring this up to the dean. What could our committee do to have more of an influence of how these funds are spent? For example, could the research committee suggest a list of priorities that the faculty would like to see some of the overhead funds be spent on? What else can we do to learn more about where overhead goes.

The GSC (Genomics Sequencing Center) is going to move to the RI-INBRE centralized research core facility (see March 3 minutes). There is a new committee being established for the main users of the GSC and bioinformatics core to develop plans for the long-term sustainability of the sequencing instrumentation. The discussion focused on: if this new advisory committee is needed; who should be on the committee; and what should be their role? Cheryl mentioned that the dean's office has been covering maintenance contracts for cost centers.
