## ABOUT THE BACHELOR OF ARTS IN SECONDARY EDUCATION - ENGLISH:

The Secondary Education program offers a BA from the Feinstein College of Education and Professional Studies with a double major in the College of Arts and Sciences (A\&S) or the College of Environmental and Life Sciences (CELS). The A\&S and CELS major requires a minimum of 30 credit hours. Majors are available in following areas of teacher certification: Biology, Chemistry, English, French, German, History/Social Studies, Italian, Latin, Mathematics, Physics, and Spanish. Certification is also available in General Science. A single course may meet more than one general education outcome, but cannot be double counted towards the 40 -credit total. At least one course must be a Grand Challenge ( $G$ ). No more than 12 credits can have the same course code (note: HPR courses may have more than 12 credits).
