(1) Six semesters of language; must be proficient up to the 104 level in one language.

(2) APG 203; PSY 103 or 113; any SOC 100 or 200 level class

(3) COM 100; WRT 104, 105, 106, 201 or 333

(4) Not required for transfer students with 24 or more credits.

(5) Those that begin the study of German at URI and wish to do an internship in Germany should plan to enroll in the URI German Summer School after the sophomore year. This will allow them to complete their six-month internship during the summer following their junior year and the first semester of their senior year.

(6) Liberal electives are courses offered outside the College of Business Administration. Internship credits count as a liberal elective. Any Study Abroad credits that are not used to meet general education credits or College of Business Administration credits can count as liberal elective credits.

(7) Typically during junior year, students will study abroad. It is expected that 15 credits will be earned. These credits should be courses that fit the requirements of the major or minor or, if needed, general education courses.

#### BUSINESS REQUIREMENT:

To transfer from University College to College of Business Administration student must have an overall GPA of 2.5, a core GPA of 2.7 (Core includes BUS 111, 201, 202, 210, and ECN 201, 202) and have taken BUS 110 (or CSC 101).

#### GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. A minimum of 120 credit hours with an overall grade point average of 2.00.
2. An overall grade point average of 2.00 (including all attempts) is mandatory for the eight 300 and 400 level courses required for the Global Business major (BUS 428, 468, 460 and four International courses chosen by student). Half the credits in the major (four courses) must be completed at URI.

#### TRANSFER CREDIT:

1. Students who wish to study at another college or university must obtain prior approval from the Dean's Office and earn a grade of C or better for the credits to transfer. **Note:** The credits transfer, not the grade.
2. Credit transferred from a community or junior college is limited to half the credits required for the University of Rhode Island degree. For a degree in business administration, that limit is 60 credits. Junior and senior level business courses are accepted only from colleges accredited by The International Association for Management Education (AACSB). Upper-level business courses taken at an institution not accredited by this agency or at two-year institutions must be validated by examination. Courses that are not validated will be given credit as free electives. To schedule a waiver exam please contact (401) 874-4377.
