B.A. – requires a second major; minimum 120 credits. Minimum GPA requirement 2.50 overall (at program admission); once admitted minimum GPAs of 2.50 overall, 2.50 Elementary Education, 2.50 second major.

It is recommended that you complete **WRT 104, COM 100, the math requirement (MTH 208 recommended), one Science, HIS 141 or 142, PSY 113** and begin your foreign language prior to applying to the major. Foreign Language (required): - 0-6 credits _____ <u>Take courses</u> or <u>test out of</u> this requirement. It can be <u>waived</u> if you were born in another country. If students choose to <u>go aboard for a semester</u> , it must be completed by the second semester of their sophomore year; this requires an early application in December of sophomore year. <u>In order to apply:</u> <i>Applicants must fulfill a testing requirement, and have at least a 2.50 GPA. To find out more details about traditional application, and the Teacher Education Scholar program, visit: www.uri.edu/hss/education - Applicant Information</i>	<u>After Admission only (Sequential)</u> - In program sem. 2, 3 and 4, candidates are assigned to <u>cohorts</u> . This determines the section students will enroll in for each of their courses. Each semester requires a <u>practicum</u> . We assign placements. Keep a morning free in sem. 1 and 2, and keep one full day free in sem. 3. Complete your second major & general education courses by sem. 3. <u>Required Certification Tests</u> -take and pass before sem. 3 (fall senior year) and provide scores to the Office of Teacher Education (701 Chafee) by September 1 st .
