It can be <u>waived</u> if you were born in another country. If students choose to <u>go aboard for a semester</u> , it must be completed by the second semester of their sophomore year; this requires an early application in December of sophomore year. <u>Before Application</u> Application consists of a test, at least a 2.50 GPA, submission of an application, a portfolio and interview. Candidates apply in January of their sophomore year For further information on the application process: www.uri.edu/hss/education - Prospective Applicants	<u>After Admission only (Sequential)</u> - In program sem. 2, 3 and 4, candidates are assigned to <u>cohorts</u> . This determines the section students will enroll in for each of their courses. Each semester requires a <u>practicum</u> . We assign placements. Keep a morning free in sem. 1 and 2, keep one full day free in sem. 3. Complete your second major & general education courses by sem. 3. <u>Required Certification Tests</u> -take and pass before sem. 3 (fall senior year) and provide scores to the Office of Teacher Education (701 Chafee) by September 1 st . Elementary Education Content Knowledge Exam (#5031) + PLT, grades K-6 (#0622); ML Praxis-by content. The <u>Middle Level</u> and <u>ESL</u> Endorsements require additional course work including content area courses, practicums, and student teaching.
