ABOUT THE INTERNATIONAL STUDIES BA DEGREE:

The International Studies and Diplomacy (ISD) program is a dual, interdependent major program with courses across several disciplines. Students in the program must complete two majors: one in International Studies (33 credits) and another in an approved language (30 credits). Upon graduation, students will be ready for careers in Foreign Service, diplomacy, multilateral and non-governmental organizations, and other international careers. In order to major in International Studies, students must also major in a language.
