The following are the RI state requirements for teacher education programs. These are subject to change at any time during your program:

- Students must take pass all 3 sections of the Praxis I: Pre-professional Skills Test (PPST) or have a composite reading and math SAT score of 1150 to be eligible to apply for the Health and Physical Education (HPE) program.
- Students in the HPE program must take and pass the Praxis II: PLT Test, the P-12 Physical Education Content Knowledge test, and the P-12 Health Education Content Knowledge Test to be eligible to student teach. Students who do not pass these exams may take 12 additional credits of course work including at least 6 credits at the 300-400 level to receive their degree but will not be eligible for teacher certification.
