The following are the RI state requirements for teacher education programs. These are subject to change at any time during your program:

- Students must take pass all 3 sections of the Praxis I: Pre-professional Skills Test (PPST) or have a composite reading and math SAT score of 1150 to be eligible to apply for the Physical and Health Education Teacher Education (PHETE) program.
- Students in the PHETE program must take and pass the Praxis II: PLT Test, the P-12 Physical Education Content Knowledge test, and the P-12 Health Education Content Knowledge Test to be eligible to student teach. Students who do not pass these exams may take 15 additional credits of course work (to replace EDC 485, 486, 487) including at least 6 credits at the 300-400 level to receive their degree but will not be eligible for teacher certification.
