Information for Students

General Education Pointers:

For a list of courses that satisfy General Education requirements consult the Arts & Sciences requirements found in the General Education Courses Booklet for the year that you first matriculated at URI.

Note: General Education credits cannot be satisfied by courses from the major course code unless the student has double majors. In that case, the student may use <u>one course</u> from <u>one of the majors</u> to also count as a general education course.

To explore the Psychology Major: PSY 113 and 232, 235, or 254 will provide an introduction.

Requirements to Transfer from University College to the College of Arts and Sciences:

- PSY 113 and 200 (300) with a C or higher in each course
- Two courses from PSY 323, 235, 254 with a C average or higher,
- A minimum of 24 earned credits and a cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher.

If you have to repeat a course: Students who must repeat a course to meet the minimum grade requirement may use only three credits of that particular course toward graduation.

ELECTIVE CREDITS: THERE IS NO REQUIRED AMOUNT OF ELECTIVE CREDITS. Elective credits make up the difference between a student's *major* requirements, *general education* requirements, *minor* requirements, and the minimum number of credits required for graduation (120 credits).

Students are <u>encouraged</u> to study at least one other discipline of interest. **Double majors and/or minors** may be constructed from these elective courses. To complement the major, you also may fulfill 6 – 15 of your 300 level elective credits by completing an internship (ITR credits). Contact your advisor and visit http://www.uri.edu/internships/

Upper Level Courses: The 42 credits of 300+ classes are not all from PSY courses; <u>any</u> discipline codes can be used.

Minors: Undergraduate students may declare a "minor" field of study by completing 18 credits or more. Descriptions of requirements for approved departmental minors can be found on the websites for departments. Approved interdepartmental minors can be found in the catalog (pg. 35).

The form for declaring a minor may be filed when you transfer to Arts and Sciences or when you reach 60 credits—whichever comes first. Classes in your minor do not have to be complete prior to filing your minor form with the Dean's Office, but you must include all classes required for the minor on the form.
