PLEASE NOTE:

Secondary Education/College of Education and Professional Studies major notes: See a Secondary Education advisor to ensure successful completion of the Secondary Education major and English teacher certification requirements. English specialization GPA must be 2.5 or higher in order to complete the Secondary Education/English program. 120 total credits required to graduate.

English major/ College of Arts & Sciences notes: See an English Department advisor to ensure successful completion of the English BA double major and complete a separate English major curriculum sheet (not this specialization form). English majors must complete 36 ENG credits, and no more than 52 ENG credits. At least 20 ENG credits must be numbered 300 or above. No more than 12 ENG credits may count towards General Education requirements. No course may be used to fill more than one requirement. 120 total credits are required to graduate. At least 42 credits must be at the 300 level or above.
