# Supporting Engagement in the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning: **A Needs Assessment Self-Study**

## Background

This needs assessment self-study sought to understand instructor engagement in the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning (SoTL) – the systematic inquiry into teaching and learning with the intention to improve student learning and the results are shared publicly - and to use this feedback to inform institutional efforts to better support and promote SoTL work.<sup>1</sup>



## Method

- Administered survey via Qualtrics to all individuals teaching courses in Fall 2021 (N = 1,511).
- 423 instructors completed the survey for a response rate of 28%.


