Fall 2022 Deadline

The application deadline is Thursday, October 6, 2022, for applicants pursuing in-person programs or internships start between December 1, 2022, to October 31, 2023. This cycle encompasses Winter or January term 2023, Spring 2023, Maymester 2023, Summer 2023, Fall 2023, and Academic Year 2023-2024 programs.

Spring 2023 Deadline

The application deadline is Tuesday, March 7, 2023. The March 2023 Deadline application will open in mid-January 2023 for applicants pursuing in-person programs or internships start between May 1, 2023 to April 30, 2024. This cycle encompasses Summer 2023, Fall 2023, Academic Year 2023-2024, and Spring 2024 programs or internships.

Even if you are not planning to study abroad during the upcoming semester, these sessions will provide helpful information on funding a program in the future – it's never too early to start!
