SENIOR CITIZEN WAIVER INSTRUCTIONS Accelerated Online Programs SPRING 2023

Rhode Island residents that are at least 60 years of age may be eligible for a waiver of tuition for courses taken at URI.

Students must submit the following:

- 1. RI Public Higher Education Senior Citizen Means Test.
- 2. Signed Copy of 2021 Federal Form 1040
- 3. Copy of RI Driver's License or RI State ID
- 4. Payment of required fees not covered by the waiver

NOTE: Tuition waiver requests will not be processed if forms are incomplete, documentation is missing, or if payment for required fees is not presented. Waivers cannot be used for non-credit courses, program fees, or audit fees.

IMPORTANT NOTICE:

Waiver recipients enrolled in a degree program (matriculated students) **are required** to apply for Financial Aid by filing the 2022-2023 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Please apply online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. (To complete Step 6 of the FAFSA form, students should enter 003414, University of Rhode Island, Kingston, RI.) The FAFSA, and any verification documentation requested by Enrollment Services, will be used to determine financial aid eligibility. Any scholarship or grant aid awarded will be applied toward your tuition in lieu of your waiver, and the amount of your waiver will be reduced accordingly. Waiver applications will be returned or denied if the FAFSA is not completed.
