Your 2022-2023 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law requires that before finalizing your financial aid application, you must provide additional information, including the submission of 2020 W-2 or equivalent documents, such as a Wage and Income Transcript. An individual who is required to submit a 2020 IRS Form W-2 or an equivalent document, but did not maintain their copy, should request a duplicate from the employer who issued the original or from the government agency that issued the equivalent document. If an individual is unable to obtain a duplicate 2020 W-2 or an equivalent document in a timely manner, regulations permit that individual to provide a signed statement, in accordance with [34 CFR 668.57\(a\)\(6\)](#). You must complete and sign this worksheet and submit all information to the address or fax number provided on the right.
