



The Rhode Island Board of Education requires the filing of an Official Enrollment Form every year that summarizes student enrollment at each of the institutions in the Rhode Island higher education system as of the census date each fall semester. At the University of Rhode Island that date is October 15th. These documents were created by the Office of Institutional Research and serve as a concise accounting of the distribution of students by various categories.

This form enumerates student by level, academic objective, residency, gender, and race/ethnicity. Percent of total for all categories in each student level (line) is calculated.

Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) are calculated based on typical credit loads per semester.

Notes identify caveats and other factors affecting this representation of the data.
