**BASIC FUNCTION:**

Plan, organize, direct, and implement all phases of a highly competitive Division I Field hockey program for women to include budget preparation and oversight, scheduling, travel, equipment, recruitment; oversee the academic and athletic development of student-athletes; conduct fundraising activities, and participate in public relations events; adhere to University, NCAA, and Atlantic-Ten Conference rules and regulations.

**ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Responsible for preparing and overseeing the program's budget.

Coordinate all recruiting, practice sessions, training and conditioning for student-athletes.

Support the University's academic goals; oversee the academic and athletic development of student-athletes.

Supervise and evaluate the staff.

Adhere to all NCAA, University, and Atlantic-Ten Conference rules and regulations.

**OTHER DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Conduct fundraising activities and participate in public relations events.

Perform other duties as required.

**LICENSES, TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT:**

NCAA Rules Certification.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS:**

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

The following are required: Bachelor's degree; a minimum of three years of successful coaching experience in women's field hockey at the collegiate club or intercollegiate level; recruiting experience; and excellent organizational, administrative, communicative, and leadership skills. Preference given to candidates possessing the following: master's degree; competitive collegiate field hockey playing experience; computer literacy. Appointment subject to NCAA violation report clearance and the successful completion of the NCAA rules certification exam.
