**BASIC FUNCTION:**

Work as part of the Web Communications team to develop, maintain and enhance URI's websites, applications, and web elements for the public-facing websites of the University of Rhode Island with a strong focus toward user experience, accessibility, SEO principles, and client specifications.

**ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Develop and extend the WordPress CMS framework, and develop software using PHP, JavaScript, HTML, CSS, SQL, and/or other languages.

Configure and develop websites including designing, writing, and implementing new application software, plugins, and enhancements to existing application software.

Assist with establishing and maintaining a development environment that uses industry best practices for change management including proper use of code repositories, properly leveraging development-test-production environments, security, and adhering to programming standards.

Perform regular testing and updates to plugins and WordPress core.

Coordinate the tracking, implementation, and testing of software.

Maintain code repositories.

Troubleshoot issues as required.

Provide documentation and technical support for supported applications. Provide technical support and training as needed to content managers across campus.

Collaborate with IT staff and/or web hosting provider(s) on routine maintenance, troubleshooting, and feature changes.

**OTHER DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Maintain technical skills to ensure currency with new and emerging web technologies.

Maintain a high level of understanding of current developments in the assigned areas of responsibility and anticipate future needs.

Perform other duties as required.
