- Executive Sponsors
 - Provost DeHayes
 - Vice President Valentino
- Goals:
 - Collaborate to improve the delivery of IT services
 - Align University IT as a strategic partner
- IT Review Steering Committee (web.uri.edu/itreview):
 - Academic and Administrative representatives
 - Fall 2014 – Winter 2016 (hand-off to ITgov)
 - Charge: Governance, Assessment, Strategic Plan

IT Review process...

- Assessment and Strategic Plan project
 - Assessment phase kickoff September 17
 - Data – ITS plus 36 departments & divisions
 - 180+ individuals interviewed
 - All faculty, staff, students surveyed online
 - ✓ Nearly 1,000 responses received
- Governance: IT Strategic Governance Committee (ITgov)
 - December 2015
 - University IT as a strategic partner
 - Engage University community, prioritization, strategy, goals

5-year University Wide IT Strategic Plan

(5 year period is to keep the IT Plan in sync with the Academic Plan)

- ✓ IT Assessment (Completed)
 - September 17 – February 29
- 1. Work Sessions to create first draft
 - March 28 – Late April
- 2. Present first draft to campus for comment
 - Early May
- 3. Update draft with results of campus review
 - Late May
- 4. Present second draft to Executive Sponsors
 - June 1
- 5. Final draft
 - June

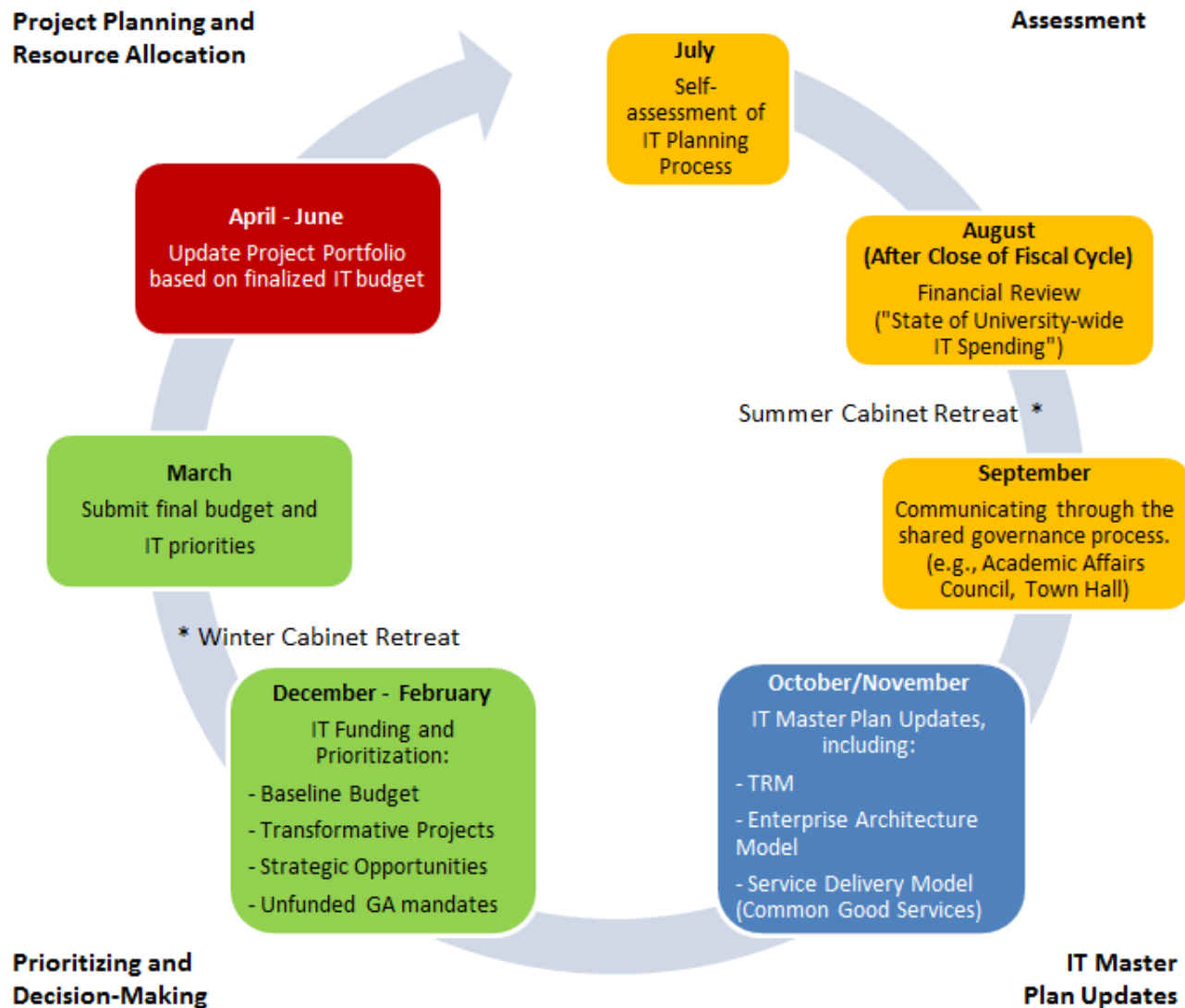
