

Clarification on WT and WTC

Question: What is the difference between the Walk Trot (WT) and Walk Trot Canter (WTC) Divisions. So to clarify – these are the divisions at all RI 4-H Horse Shows.

4-H Senior WTC - open to 4-H riders 14 and over

4-H Junior WTC - open to 4-H riders 13 and under

4-H Junior WT- open to 4-H riders 13 and under who have never shown at the canter/ lope

4-H Senior WT- open to 4-H riders 14 and over who have never shown at the canter/ lope

These divisions are determined by the 4-H rider and do not change if the 4-Her changes horses or seat (English, Saddle Seat or Western)

The 4-Her's age is as January 1st of the current 4-H year.

Only WTC riders are eligible for Eastern States Exposition so to have a 4-H show count as a qualifier they need to be in the Junior or Senior WTC Divisions.
