II. Approval of Minutes of Meeting Number 539, April 5, 2021

- A. Fellowship & Scholarships update (Mosley Austin)
 - 1. Associate Dean Mosely Austin announced that there were ten Tuition Scholarships, five Dean's Fellowships, and four Dean's Diversity Fellowship awardees. All recipients were notified of their award. The Graduate School is waiting on a couple of responses for acceptance.

- A. EGRA Discussion; (1)Timing Earlier announcement and deadline, (2) Allow for group proposals, (3) Increasing award amount (DeBoef & Mosley Austin)
 - 1. Dean DeBoef and Associate Dean Mosley Austin discussed the issues with students not using the EGRA funds within the allotted time and proposing to accept group proposals.
 - 2. The Council agreed to have group proposals. The council suggested providing additional details on the purchase procedure/policy to students, developing a mechanism to allow for survey incentives like gift cards, allowing for an extension for the length of the award, and analyzing the unspent funds to see if there is a pattern.

- a) Council members mentioned they use Amazon gift cards as an incentive to participants. At the end of the survey, the participant can enter their email address and the gift card is sent electronically. A report can be produced of the recipients.
- b) Infoready has the ability to enable a progress feature to allow students to upload receipts and also provide notice if they are unable to use the funds awarded.
