- the General Education Subcommittee shall study and make recommendations to the full committee (Curriculum & Standards) concerning the establishment, modification or abolition of General Education requirements for graduation to be applicable to degree candidates; consider new and existing courses proposed for general education, which the full committee did refer to the subcommittee; evaluate the effectiveness of the general education program; maintain liaison with the University administration for effective implementation of approved recommendations; and cooperate closely with the Director of General Education.

# OUR INTENTIONS FOR THIS YEAR

- **Our Intentions for this Year**
- Our primary focus for the year is to evaluate the effectiveness of the General Education program.
  - prepare and distribute a faculty survey questionnaire regarding the program and distribute it to the faculty, and
  - prepare and distribute an administrator survey questionnaire regarding the program to the Deans of all colleges with undergraduate programs and/or General Education course offerings.
  - Prepare a student survey questionnaire for undergraduate students on their views of the program
  - Review the assessment process of the program
  - Review the administration of General Education, including
    - the course approval process and instruments used in that process
    - the supply of General Education seats across outcomes, majors and colleges
