The Office of the Provost and the Executive Committee of the Faculty Senate announce the <u>Sheila Black Grubman Faculty Outstanding Service Award</u>.

The award is made to a member of the URI faculty who has consistently dedicated time, thought, and energy and made important contributions while serving on the Faculty Senate, committees, task forces, working groups, and/or through other activities that promote the interests of the University community as a whole.

Faculty are invited to nominate peers who exemplify service to the University. Full-time faculty members, who have held their position for at least three years, who are not currently members of the Faculty Senate Executive Committee and have not served on the Executive Committee for at least two years prior to the current year, are eligible for the award.

The recipient will be honored at the May 7, 2020 meeting of the Faculty Senate and will receive an Outstanding Service plaque and a financial award of \$2,000. In addition, the recipient will be invited to join the platform party at commencement.
