1) CALL TO ORDER

The Faculty Senate Executive Committee (FSEC) WebEx meeting was called to order at 9:03 by Chair Nassersharif. Vice-Chair Echevarria and Senators Barbour, Gindy, Hicks and Morokoff were in attendance. Guest: President Dooley

2) MEETING WITH PRESIDENT DOOLEY

The President provided an update on topics associated with the COVID-19 virus at URI. The President reported that the May commencement is being postponed and students are being polled for alternative commencement suggestions. He will share the poll results with the URI community. The President also reported that URI students have been sent prorated refunds of housing and dining. Remaining students have been consolidated on campus in rooms by themselves. Belongings of students who have left the campus have been boxed and stored. Counseling through telehealth for students has been on-going. URI research is on-going with strict guidelines of sanitizing and social distancing in place. In the library, a closed stack system is in place. Requested library materials are left at the main desk for pick-up. Vice Provost Libutti and his team have continued to reach out through social media campaigns, virtual tours of campus and student conversation events to recruit and retain students. There exist opportunities for faculty to reach out to prospective students through WebEx and social media. An initial meeting via videoconference of the new Board of Trustees is planned for April. The leadership is hoping for a Board gathering and orientation in June. President Dooley is looking forward to the April 2nd meeting during which the Senate will vote on an optional alternative grading scheme for the Spring 2020 semester.
