

Academic Standards & Calendar Committee
Report # 2014-15-3

The Academic Standards and Calendar Committee met on 5 February 2015 to consider a late-January request from the Provost to modify the Spring 2015 Calendar based on missed snow days.

As of 16 February, classes have been cancelled on three Monday evenings, two Monday days, one Tuesday, and one Wednesday due to adverse weather events. Many of the courses that have missed days have been able to keep up with their schedules by using online spaces. The majority of courses are on track. However, the committee recognizes that not all classes can be sustained in an online environment, and that Monday-only evening classes have been deeply affected, having not yet met.

The proposal stemming from the 5 February meeting included an invitation to faculty to use President's Day as an optional Monday makeup day, and a proposal to make up any *additional* missed snow days on Thursday, 30 April and Friday, 1 May.

Because of an additional closure on Monday, 9 February (after the committee met, but before Faculty Senate met), the committee revised the proposal, proposing making up a Monday with the 30 April make-up day scheduled into the calendar.

The provost approved using Thursday, 30 April as a Monday make-up day, and announced that change. The provost then asked the committee to revise its previous proposals and find a way to propose making up at least three days.

The committee discussed various options via email and agreed (all voting in favor but one) to approve the following proposal, which adds days without changing the published exam schedule:

Modified Spring 2015 Calendar

The committee proposes the following, which makes up 3 full days and an additional Monday evening:

- Make **Friday, 6 March** a makeup for **Monday evening** classes starting at or after 4pm.
- Extend the last day of classes from Wednesday, 29 April to Saturday, 2 May.
- Make **Thursday, 30 April** a **Monday** meeting schedule. (Note: 30 April is already approved in the calendar as a make-up day and this change has already been approved and announced. We include it here for clarity, not for approval.)
- Make **Friday, 1 May** a **Tuesday** meeting schedule.
- Make **Saturday, 2 May** a **Wednesday** meeting schedule.
- Use **Sunday, 3 May** as Reading Day
- Maintain the exam period as originally scheduled.
