

Report of the Constitution and By-laws Committee No. 2019-20-4 Faculty Senate Meeting May 7, 2020

The following legislation provides a route for non matriculated undergraduate students to matriculate through either the Office of Admissions or ASFCEPS OSI. Dean Anthony Rolle was consulted and stated that the college has no concerns with the language as amended.

Original Language:

8.20.72 Students pursuing solely an Undergraduate Certificate only must be admitted through the Alan Shawn Feinstein College of Education and Professional Studies, Office of Strategic Initiatives upon the recommendation of the appropriate admissions officer.

Recommended Change:

8.20.72 Students pursuing solely an Undergraduate Certificate must be admitted through **the Office of Admissions or** the Alan Shawn Feinstein College of Education and Professional Studies, Office of Strategic Initiatives upon the recommendation of the appropriate admissions officer.
