



## UNIVERSITY OF RHODE ISLAND FACULTY SENATE

At the May 7, 2015 Meeting of the Faculty Senate, the following amended section of the By-Laws of the Faculty Senate was first moved. It is now returned to the Faculty Senate for a vote per Section 12.1 of the By-Laws, Amendment of By-Laws.

## Current language with proposed changes highlighted in red:

**4.50** The Library Committee. This committee shall act as liaison between the University Library and the faculty as a whole and advise the Library on matters of general faculty concern; consult with the Library faculty on long-range needs of the Library and the adequacy of budget provisions to meet those needs; serve in an advisory capacity to the Faculty Senate regarding the implementation and interpretation of the University of Rhode Island Open-Access Policy, resolving disputes concerning the interpretation and application of the policy, and recommending changes in the policy to the Faculty Senate; report annually to the Faculty Senate and propose Senate action relating to the University Library. The Faculty Senate Designate for the URI Open-Access Policy shall serve as a voting ex officio member of the Library Committee. The Dean of University Libraries shall serve as an ex officio non-voting member of the Library Committee.

## Final language as proposed:

**4.50** The Library Committee. This committee shall act as liaison between the University Library and the faculty as a whole and advise the Library on matters of general faculty concern; consult with the Library faculty on long-range needs of the Library and the adequacy of budget provisions to meet those needs; serve in an advisory capacity to the Faculty Senate regarding the implementation and interpretation of the University of Rhode Island Open-Access Policy, resolving disputes concerning the interpretation and application of the policy, and recommending changes in the policy to the Faculty Senate; report annually to the Faculty Senate and propose Senate action relating to the University Library. The Faculty Senate Designate for the URI Open-Access Policy shall serve as a voting ex officio member of the Library Committee. The Dean of University Libraries shall serve as an ex officio non-voting member of the Library Committee.
