The new College of Health Sciences was approved by the Board of Education in July 2015. It is composed of six health-related departments--Communicative Disorders, Human Development and Family Studies, Kinesiology, Nutrition and Food Sciences, Physical Therapy, and Psychology--and one degree-granting program, Health Studies. Five of the departments/programs --Communicative Disorders, Health Studies, Human Development and Family Studies, Kinesiology, and Physical Therapy-- were part of the College of Human Science and Services, which will be dissolved as of June 30, 2016.
